## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What will we accomplish in our Soul Construction capital campaign?**

Great question! Soul Construction will finance and complete Phase I of the Master Plan approved by you in March, 2008. Phase I includes the construction of the Main Worship area, Administrative offices and a multipurpose building for the Children, Student and Adult ministries to share. Phase I also includes parking spaces for 500 cars.

### **How much will it cost to build?**

Phase 1 of the Master Plan costs \$12 million dollars.


### **What is our soul construction goal?**

The Soul Construction capital campaign goal is to raise \$5 million dollars over 3 years. We will reach our goal through commitment pledges. You can make your commitment either by giving weekly, monthly or quarterly over three years.

### **Why build now?**

Another great question! The practical answer is because we're completely out of room in our current facility. More importantly, we have to build now to have more space to do Great Commission work. God tells us to go and build people, not buildings. "Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Matthew 28:19-20

### **How should I go about making my commitment?**

We want you to pray first. Soul Construction is about God reshaping our hearts to be more responsive to Him. As you pray about your commitment consider your regular tithes and ask God what he wants you to sacrifice for a greater you and a Greater Building! See Pledge Process

We are asking each household to:

- Faithfully tithe as we continue to grow (Acts 20:35).
- Make a three-year commitment to give above and beyond your regular tithes and offerings to ‘Soul Construction’ on Commitment Sunday, October 12, 2008.
- Participate in the First Fruit Offering on October 12. The First Fruit Offering will be the initial offering we give to begin our three-year commitment.

### **Will my monetary commitments be made public?**

Absolutely not! Your contribution to Soul Construction is a commitment between you and God. We simply ask that you listen to God and then obey Him as He leads you.
